A new ENOS project has been initiated to follow up on the <u>GetWet initiative</u> towards inclusive water sports. The project is further focused on enhancing health and well being through water sport and giving health guidelines and programs for various water sport operators.

Goals of the 'Outdoor Water Sport for Health' project :

- 1. Empowering people towards better health and health competence through outdoor water sports.
- 2. Developing guidelines for European water sports operators and their instructors in order to engage groups with diverse health needs.
- 3. Initiate sustainible development in outdoor water sport and increase awareness and connection to the environment of people.





Strong partnership in place for B.O.S.S.

The project being facilitated by the European Network of Outdoor Sports (ENOS) brings added value to the BOSS project. The existing commitment and strong partnership collaboration in place is valuable to support a widespread dissemination of the knowledge gained and the results provided.

The working group hope that the unique BOSS project will support a policy shift for improved investment and resultant participation in physical activity in the outdoors across Europe.

In March a first working group meeting has been held in Munich. The academic partners agreed on a definition for outdoor sports and a searching strategy to carry out the literature review of the first step of the project.

Actually, the partners of all participating countries are gathering evidence on the social benefits and are reviewing existing studies including: health and well-being.
